### Message from Mrs Money

As you are aware over the last 3 weeks we have had some confirmed cases of Covid across the school. It has been incredible to not have had any confirmed cases until now, however it is important that together we strive to preserve the children's time in school by continuing to be vigilant. Congratulations to the Year 2 children who took part in the Multi-skills competition held at Heather Ridge Infants last week. The children were amazing and showed great team work, were impeccably behaved and also won the trophy for Sandringham!

Thank you to Mrs Bellchambers who has started an ECO Warrior club with some of the children from after school club. The team will be looking at how we recycle at school and have started this with collecting old used felt tip pens. When we have 1600 pens they will be sent to be cleaned, melted and moulded into new recycled products. Proceeds from sales of these products then go to Ellie's Fund which supports BTRS (brain tumours research and support). 
# YEAR 2 MULTI-SKILLS
