Message from Mrs Money

I hope that you have all had a wonderful week enjoying the incredible sunshine. We really have been blessed with great weather over the last few months and it has certainly helped that the children both in school and at home can be outside for much of the day.

The children in school have adapted incredibly well to their new bubbles and staff continue to make this experience positive and exciting. For children and parents still at home, I really do appreciate how challenging this may be for you all. This week I was really hoping for news that schools could re-open fully before the end of term. I know that transition to Reception, to new year groups and to Junior schools remains a concern for parents and children. Please believe that I will do anything within my power to ensure that this still happens for all of the children whether this is at the end of term or at the very beginning of September. Guidelines continue to change regularly and I open every daily DFE update with the hope that it will allow <u>all</u> of our children to come back so that our school family can feel complete again. Current guidelines say that school will re-open fully to all children in September and this is fantastic news for everyone.

I am also aiming to open our Woodlands breakfast and after school club again in September. Thank you to those of you who responded to the survey this week - this has confirmed that there is a need for this provision from working parents and I know that the team are really excited about the prospect of being back with the children.

<u>Reading books</u> - please return books to school on Monday mornings only. If returned, new books will be sent home after school on a Monday. Books will only be accepted on this day as this ensures the returns are sealed and quarantined for 3 days before being returned to the system. It was wonderful to see so many of our children who are still at home at our Monday afternoon book exchange. Feedback from you is that children and parents loved being back inside the school gates and seeing their teachers. Please can I ask you and your children to stay on the school paths and follow the one way system out of school at all times. We are really looking forward to seeing you next Monday afternoon.
