Message from Mrs Money

We have reached the end of the first half term of this academic year and I would like to start by saying thank you to the whole community for supporting me in all of the modifications to school life within Covid government guidelines. We have managed to stay fully staffed and without any bubble closures, which is fantastic news within the current climate. This is down to everyone's efforts surrounding cleaning routines, handwashing, staying away from school when unwell and adhering to track and trace guidelines. Thank you.

After half term we are asking parents to wear masks at school drop off and pick ups. Whilst this is obviously your own choice as you remain outside and in control of your own social distancing, we do feel that this is in the interests of yourselves and other parents safety. As a staff team we have discussed this also applying to staff at drop off and pick up times. So much of the welcome and settling for children in the morning is based around facial expression and smiles so we have made the decision together that this remains a priority. Staff will therefore, for the time being, not wear masks. However, for us to be able to do this it is essential that parents remain socially distanced from staff at all times please. After half term our one way system will continue along with clearer drop off point signs for children and we ask that parents do not go past these in order to keep staff safe. Without healthy staff I am unable to keep the school open so hope that you will wholly support me in this.

Since the last newsletter we have held some events in school which have all been very successful. Parents evenings on teams/phone went smoothly and although meetings in person are of course preferable, feedback has been very positive. If you haven't yet spoken with your child's teacher please contact the school office to make an appointment for after half term. We had a whole school fire practise last week which ensures that the whole school community knows how to exit safely in the event of a fire. It was so lovely for all of the children to actually see different year groups, we really enjoyed lots of waving across the playground to each other!

Thank you all for your overwhelming donations for the harvest collection. The children came to the hall in their bubbles and added their donations to the harvest table. A huge thank you to Lucille Double and Chloe Webb for helping me to pack away the goodies which will be taken to the local foodbank after half term.

Today you will have been emailed a school fund donation letter outlining how we ask families to support us this year in funding all of the wonderful extras in school. You will also receive a KITE newsletter. Please take the time to read these and to complete the parents survey regarding the continuation of Friday afternoon school closure in January. Your views are essential in the decision regarding this.
