Message from Mrs Money

It is wonderful to be back at school this week and it really made my morning yesterday being greeted by lots of smiley children and parents! Thank you all so much for being so supportive of the school staff over the last few weeks in my absence. With this high level of absence, the remaining staff have worked incredibly hard and with the extra help of the sports coach Tom, supply teachers Mrs Calvert and Mrs Fairley, the team have kept school as normal as possible for the children. I hope that children and parents at home are not too poorly and we look forward to seeing you back to school soon.

Cases in Year 2 have settled and Mrs Hylton and most of the children have returned to school. The staff in Year 1 have been returning this week however cases in children remain high, so please ensure that you do not send children to school if they have any symptoms. Staff in Reception are also returning this week and although there are only a few cases in children this is on the increase, so again please be vigilant in spotting symptoms and testing. Staffing absence also meant that Nursery has needed to close for a few days however we are pleased to share that this will open again as normal on Wednesday lunchtime. Breakfast Club continues as normal however After School Club will continue to stay closed for at least the remainder of this week.

Due to this outbreak of Covid cases in school each year group and staff are remaining exclusively together for as much of the day as possible. As per guidance from Public Health England we are not currently holding assemblies all together, have requested parents to wear masks on site and are limiting visitors into school. This will continue until the end of term. Reception parents, please see separate email regarding the nativity performance this year which will be sent out to families tomorrow.

We have endeavoured to continue with as many events in school as possible despite having to adhere to the above outbreak guidance. Thankfully the Panto company have agreed to perform to us in the New Year so we have something to look forward to on our return to school. The children and staff all enjoyed the Reindeer Run last week - please send any fundraising envelopes to the school office this week as they are being collected this Friday. The Christmas Fayre has been rescheduled to next Monday and Tuesday so please send your children's spending money into the school office if you haven't already done so.
