We would like to ask you for your help and co-operation in a vitally important matter. Due to having a small number of children with severe allergies in our Reception classes, we have put in place a range of protective measures at school to ensure that the risk is minimised and managed. We would also be grateful if you could further support us by:

- washing your child's hands after their breakfast before they come to school;
- ensuring that they do not come to school wearing any clothes with food spilt on;
- cleaning their lunchboxes/lunch bags to ensure that there is no food on the outside.

Please also ensure that if your child brings a packed lunch that our nut-free school policy is followed.

I would like to reassure you that your own child will not be affected by any of the measures that we have put in place; however, the health and wellbeing of our Reception pupils with severe allergies may be at serious risk if these precautions were not put in place.
