Dear new Nursery families,

Welcome to Sandringham Infant & Nursery School and to the start of your child's early learning journey at Little Badgers. We are delighted that you have accepted your child's place and returned your admissions forms ready to start with us in September.

I am pleased to be able to share details of your child's transition into Little Badgers as I appreciate that many of you have been keen to receive this information. Unless the situation/guidance changes over the summer holidays our intention is for all children to return/start nursery as detailed in this letter.

We would like to invite you to an information evening on Thursday 15th July at 5pm - 6pm. There is no need to book, however this meeting will be held outside and we do ask for just 1 parent/carer to attend. This will give you the opportunity to meet the team and ask any questions you may have. We will also give you an information pack to help you with the transition into nursery. If you are unable to attend, please let the school office know so we can arrange for your pack to be collected.

We have placed our new Nursery children into 6 groups for their stay and play sessions.

Your child will be in **Butterflies Group 2**.

When they start Nursery, your child will be in **Butterflies class**.

Included with this letter is an 'I am starting Little Badgers Nursery' form for you to complete with your child. If possible please bring this form along to the information evening or alternatively please drop it into the school office before 20th July.

Please enter our Nursery grounds through the green side gate on the left hand side of the school - staff will be there to meet you and your child. For the initial family visit we will be spending the time outside so please bring appropriate clothing.

During your visit we will need to see a copy of your child's original birth certificate to allow us to claim funding on your behalf. We will also ask you to complete a declaration of attendance form for your 15 hours universal funding or a sales invoice form if your place is self funded.


Nursery Uniform

The children will be given the opportunity to visit the school library and bring a book home to share with you. They will need their own book bag. We also have some excellent condition 2nd hand ones available from the office for £5 each. Please let the office know if you would like to purchase one as there are a limited amount available.
