# Christmas in Little Badger's Nursery

As December is rapidly approaching I would like to clarify the dates and arrangements for everything that is happening between now and the end of this term for the nursery children. These dates differ from the dates given for the main school as we have both of our groups, Ladybirds and Butterflies to include in the activities. Normally we would invite you to some of our activities, however due to the current situation unfortunately we are unable to do this. We will be putting photographs and video clips onto Tapestry so that you can have an insight into and enjoy the activities that we are doing with the children during this special time of year.

### Elf Run - w/c Monday 30th November

You should all have received an envelope with information about the Elf Run event. The date given was Friday 4<sup>th</sup> December for school, but at nursery we will be doing the run twice during the week to ensure that all of the children are able to participate. We have elf hats ready for the children (and staff!) to wear and are looking forward to running to raise some money!

## <u>Christmas cards - w/c Monday 7<sup>th</sup> December</u>

The children may bring Christmas cards in for their friends and post them in the post box in nursery this week. The cards will then be quarantined and we will give them out to the children during the last week of term.

#### Christingles - w/c Monday 7th December

We will be making Christingles in nursery during the week and would be grateful if you could send your child into nursery with a largish orange by Friday 4<sup>th</sup> December. We will provide the other things that are needed for the Christingle. Thank you.

We will use our Christingles in a Christingle service with the children. For Ladybirds this will be on Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> December and for Butterflies this will be on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> December. As part of the service, the children will be fully supervised as we light the candle of our orange and sing some of our favourite Christmas carols.

# Christmas Dinner - Thursday 10th December

We would normally invite all Little Badgers to Christmas dinner, however this year we are sorry that we are unable to do this as we cannot mix 'bubbles'. If your child is in Butterflies (Wed pm, Thurs, Fri children) and you would like them to have a Christmas dinner, please order and pay for it in the normal

way. If you would like your child to have a packed lunch on this day that is fine and you don't need to do anything (except send their lunch as normal on the day!) This day is also 'Christmas Jumper' day! Ladybirds (Mon, Tues, Wed am) can wear Christmas jumpers to nursery on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> December and we will have a little treat time instead of a Christmas dinner!

### The Nativity Play

As we are unable to join Moles and Hedgehogs this year for the Nativity Play, which we usually do at the church, we are going to be doing a 'Christmas Celebration' in nursery. We will be doing this with both nursery groups. For Ladybirds this will be on **Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> December** and for Butterflies it will be on **Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> December**. Please would you send your children in Christmassy dresses, shirts, jumpers, hats etc on these days for our special celebration. We will video each celebration and put it onto Tapestry for you to enjoy.

Normally we like to bring all of our Little Badgers together for our Christmas party, but to make sure that the children still have a party we will be having two this year. For Ladybirds this will be on Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> December and for Butterflies it will be on Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> December. The children can wear party clothes to nursery and we will play games, dance and have drinks and snacks, which we will provide. Hopefully there will be a special visitor who will surprise the children! (Please keep this a secret from them!)
