ELS E-Library

Thank you to all the Reception and Year 1 Families who attended our Phonics information evening last half term. It was lovely to see so many of you and thank you again for all the positive feedback.

As discussed in the meeting, we will be launching the ELS online E-library for our school aged children to further support their phonics learning in class. As part of home learning, your child will have the opportunity to access an extra decodable text, which will be set by their class teacher. This will be in addition to the ELS decodable reading book and sharing book that they are already bringing home each week.

Next week your child will bring home a slip of paper attached to their yellow reading diary with their log in and password. To access the ELS E-library please visit the Oxford Owl website by following the link below: <https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/login?active-tab=students#>

This will bring you to a login page where it will ask you to select your user type (see image below). Click on the 'students' tab, type in your child's username and password. It will also ask you for the school code 'fep6'. Once you log in, it will take you to your child's E-library homepage, where you will see the book that has been set. Information will also be shown regarding when it needs to be handed in and your child will also be able to leave feedback on the book. Any questions regarding this, please see your child's class teacher.

We hope your children will enjoy accessing additional reads through our new e-library, which is also tablet friendly. Happy reading!
