



Dear Parents,

Please can I remind you that earrings and jewellery are not part of the uniform at Sandringham School.

If you are planning on getting your child's ears pierced, please can you wait until the Summer holidays so that they have 6 full weeks to heal before the start of term. This also ensures your child has time to learn how to take their earrings out and put them in on their own prior to starting back at school.

Due to health and safety recommendations, any child who continues to wear earrings must have them taped prior to them coming to school on PE days. Please note staff are not able to tape children's ears during the school day. This is for their own and others safety. Earrings need to be small plain studs as hoops may catch on equipment and clothing.

Parents who wish their children to continue to wear earrings in school; either whilst they heal or for other reasons, will be required to sign the disclaimer below.
