



Upon a child's arrival at an academy, the following 3 questions are to be asked:

1. Has the child or anyone in their household shown symptoms?
2. Has the child had a temperature?
3. Has the child had Calpol (or equivalent) this morning?

Yes

- Child goes home with parent.
- We recommend the child takes a test.
- Child remains at home for 14 days or until a negative test.

- We inform the bubble that there has been a symptom detected and to be extra vigilant
- The bubble does not need to go home. Parents could collect children, however this is not encouraged.

Child's Test Results Obtained

Positive

- We inform the bubble and send them home for 14 days from the moment case is confirmed.
- Cleaning takes place as per guidance

Negative

Written proof of a negative outcome is provided and the child can return to the academy.

No

Child comes into the academy

Child shows a symptom during the day

- Adult dons PPE and escorts the child straight away to isolation room.
- Parent is called.

Cleaning takes place as per guidance.
