Dear Year 1 and Year 2 Families,

Next week on Friday 10th September, we will be launching **Forest Fridays!**

This exciting new session will be led outside by class teachers every Friday afternoon and will initially commence for children in Years 1 and 2. Reception will join in the Spring term.

Forest Friday is an outdoor learning session, based upon the Forest School initiative. It allows children to actively explore their natural environment, at the same time learning new skills such as foraging, building dens and shelters, designing habitats, creating art work out of natural materials... and so much more!

We aim for sessions to take place across the school grounds and occasionally within the local environment. Forest Friday takes place in all weathers, so we ask that you carefully consider the uniform list below.

On a Friday, starting on 10th September, your child should come to school wearing:

- White polo shirt and school jumper or cardigan
- Green jogging bottoms (in addition to those for PE)
- Plain trainers

Between now and next Friday, please also ensure your child has the following items in school. Please note: these items will stay in school.

- Named welly boots
- Named lightweight waterproof jacket
- Named lightweight waterproof trousers
