Knowledge

As Historians, we will be learning about the life and times of Samuel Cody (the first man in England to build and fly a powered aircraft who pioneered aviation locally in Hampshire (events beyond living memory) (historically significant people)

As Scientists, we will be identifying and naming a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees. We will also be learning about the basic structure and labelling of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees.

As Artists, we will study Vincent Van Gogh. We will look at the technique of painting (Unit 4) in Art, as well as designing and making vehicles with moving parts.

As Musicians, we will be introduced to Boom Whackers and will be using these to explore pitch. This will form part of our Spring Celebration event.

As a Young Person, we will be considering all aspects of keeping healthy through our jigsaw programme, healthy me. We are learning about the value of Patience. We will also learn about Judaism and Easter.

As a Multi Sports Athlete, we will use bats to control balls as well as developing the skill of skipping. In gymnastics we will be revisiting floor work to incorporate rocking and rolling. We will learn to communicate as part of our team games and understand the strength of others.

As a Technologist, we will be introduced to Algorithms and revisiting the language of position, direction and sequence.
