Message from Mrs Money

I would like to start by thanking you all for supporting us either with your children in school or at home. Although we remain 'case free' in school we continue to be vigilant and recognise that this is a whole school community effort. I really do appreciate that home schooling is hard, especially if juggling your own work, younger children and older children's home learning. This can feel like an impossible task and I urge you to talk to us and each other and take one day at a time. Please be mindful of what is shared on Whatsapp groups as this can cause some parents to feel even more anxious if they aren't getting everything achieved. All remote learning now has the teacher inputs highlighted in red to help you to prioritise what to access first. There is also a remote learning tab on the website with all plans and resources. Included in this newsletter are some lovely photos of the learning which has been happening both in school and at home.

We have received a very generous donation of some laptops so please contact the school office if you are struggling to access remote learning or are sharing devices within households. Let us help you to get through these challenging times.

From Monday 22nd January, staff will be testing for Covid-19 twice a week. By testing staff on a regular basis, we will hopefully be able to minimise contacts between children and asymptomatic staff. I remain optimistic that this is a step towards the full reopening of schools.

Another thank you to a lovely parent who donated bags of fruit to school whilst deliveries stopped. These have now resumed so for children in school you no longer need to send a piece of fruit with your child every day. Milk cartons are now being delayed but please be reassured that we will be giving children who usually have milk a cup of milk instead or a carton until these issues with deliveries have been sorted out.

We were due to have parents consultation appointments over the next few weeks. Families who have children currently at home will continue to have 1-1 teams/phone calls with the teachers where you have opportunities to ask any questions. We would like to offer appointments to parents of children who are currently in school during the week of Monday 1st February. You will receive information from the school office on Monday detailing when each teacher will be available for appointments and how to book.
