Message from Mrs Money

I hope that you all had a wonderful Easter break and made the most of the sunny AND snowy weather! Hopefully the sunshine will continue as it is so lovely seeing the children return in their summer dresses and shorts. Please can you ensure that hair accessories are in school colours and that children come prepared for the British weather (named lightweight jackets, school sunhats and water bottles). Please also ensure that children have sun cream applied before coming to school when necessary.

The summer term is very busy and especially so this year as we are trying to hold some events which would usually have happened during the spring term. We will continue to follow the government guidance and consider each event carefully before confirming. Please keep a note of dates from this newsletter and check emails from the school office for updates and information.

Thank you to those of you who have already made your school fund donations. This fund helps to pay for all the lovely extras throughout the year. These are some examples of what this money has been spent on so far this year; maths and music resources, a bubble machine, world book day prizes, caterpillar houses, Mother's day flowers and card making resources, Easter egg raffle, golden tea parties, Christmas arts resources, enchanted door materials. We really do rely on this fund so please contact the school office if you are yet to make your donation and would like to.

Although uncertainty surrounding travel abroad and booking of holidays remains, schools have been asked to remind parents/carers that if they take their children out of school without authority they will be liable to receive a penalty notice. Please note that this is not a source of income for the school and is dealt with directly from Surrey county council. Currently the amount payable under a penalty notice is $\pounds 60$ per parent/carer per child if paid within 21 days. Thereafter the amount increases to $\pounds 120$ if paid within 21-28 days. If this remains unpaid after 28 days, the Local Authority may consider a prosecution in the Magistrates Court. Since penalty notices are issued per parent/carer per child a family of two parents and two children will receive 4 penalty notices.

The school perimeter fence is now completed. I am really pleased with how it looks and have had lots of lovely comments from families and passers by. The school exterior lighting and fire alarm systems have been fitted and most of the interior doors have been replaced with fire doors. The rest of the internal door work will be completed during the May half term holidays. We are also hoping to have a double door entry system built at the school office. Please be reassured that the funding for this work has not been taken from the school budget and is entirely as a result of winning a £70K grant for improving school security and safeguarding.
