"There's too many keys... surely only one of them will fit...?"



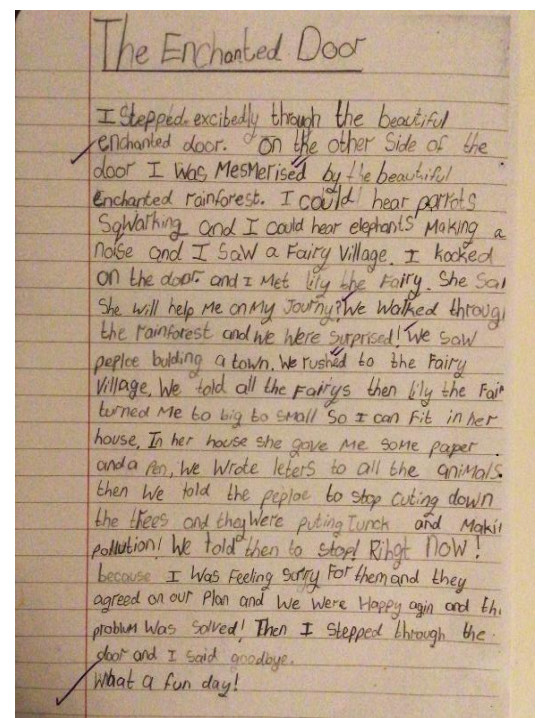
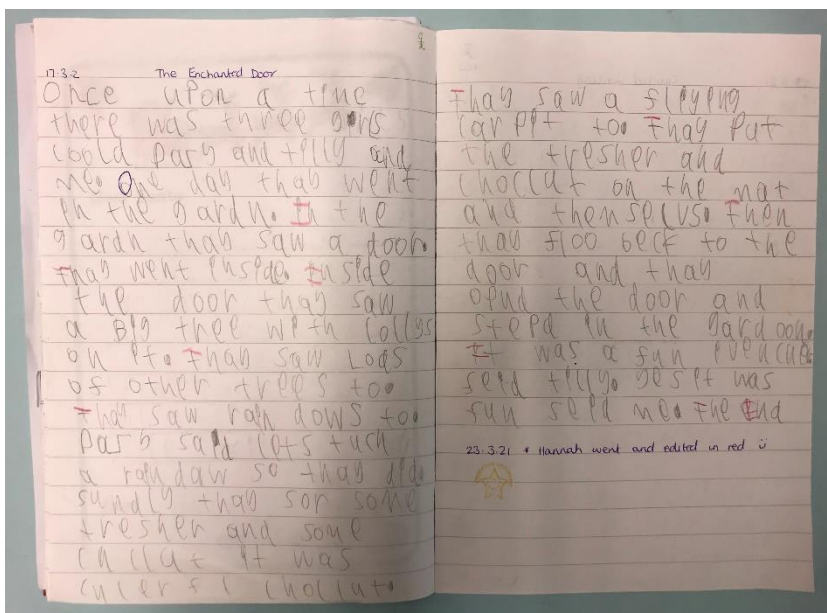
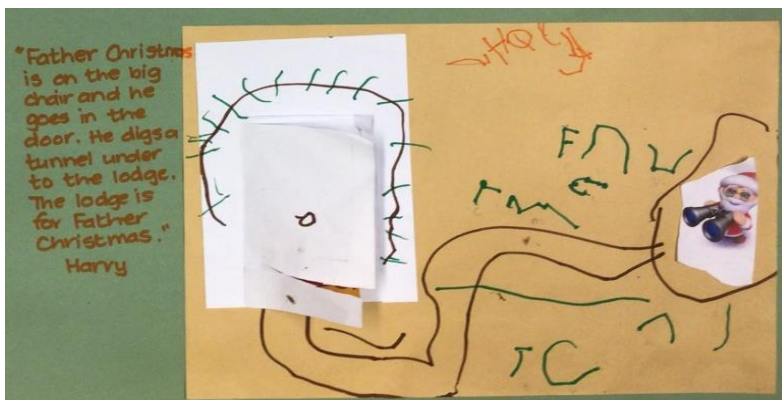
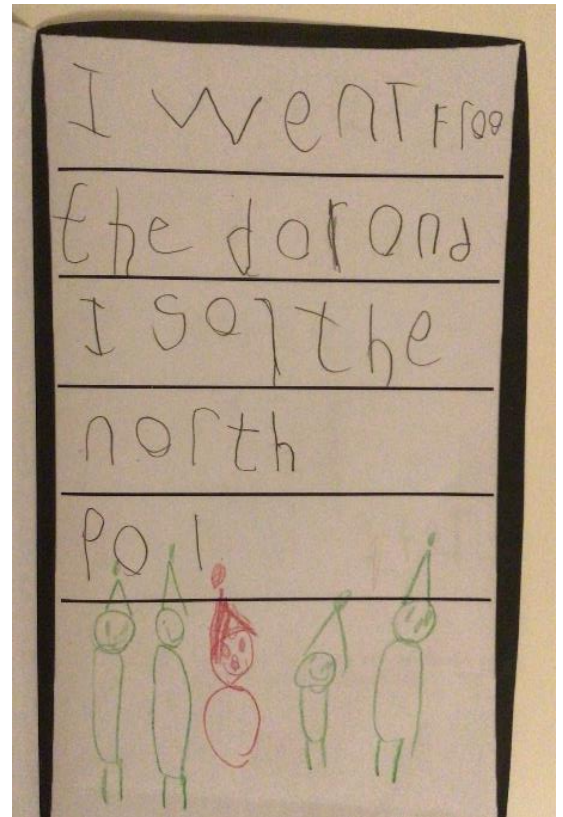
Thursday finally saw the door open a crack... where does it lead to?




