Fundraising update

We are looking to raise funds this year to help pay for a **pirate ship** for the school playground. We are looking to fundraise a £6,000-8,000 donation from the PTA towards this exciting project.

The PTA has already provided funds for other projects at school, including using the proceeds of the Grandparents Raffle to buy much-needed books for the school library and buying Reception class learning resources.

We raised an AMAZING £3,000 in the Autumn Term and we hope the events this term will help us add to that total. All funds raised are used to support our children's education so a big thank you to everyone who has supported to PTA financially or otherwise this term.
