Monday	<p>PHONICS: Contracted form - https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=sEGPVtxesjM Watch the video clip and tell a grown-up what contractions are (2 words shortened to make 1 word). See Phase 6 spelling rules if needed. (xsent home at beginning of the year)</p> <p>TOPIC: The Artic - What you know already? Record on paper. Watch Arctic PP What do you want to find out?</p> <p>MATHS: Add & Subtract 10s https://vimeo.com/464237963 Just adding today. See below for activity</p> <p>ART: Background for Polar landscape. On a piece of A4 paper use a colourwash (watered down paint) of purple for the Arctic sky and blue for the ice and paint as example below. To create the ice effect on the blue colourwash lay a piece of cling film over the paint and slightly pinch the cling film together a little. 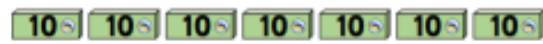

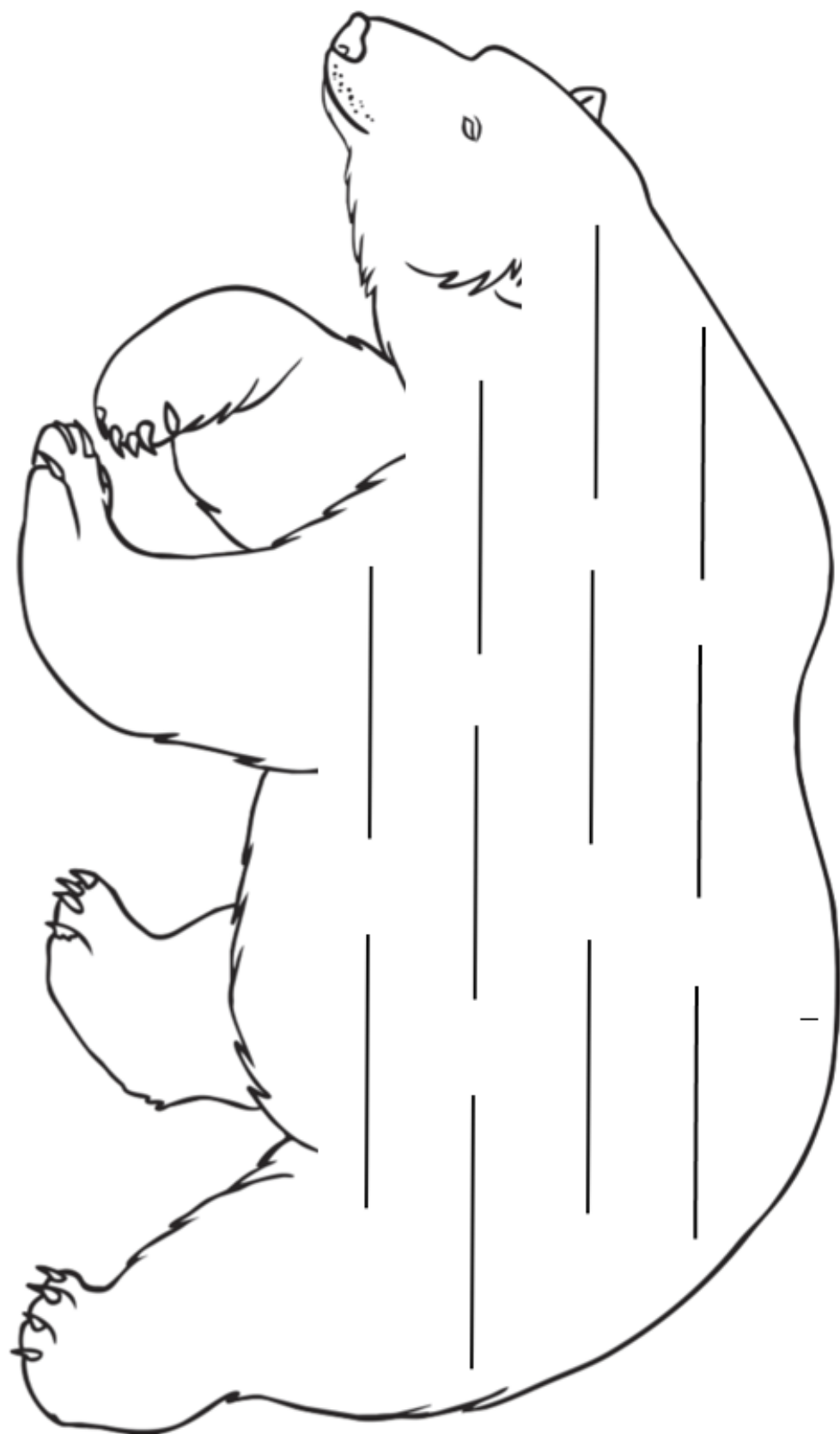

Why is it Suitable?
