| | Chn to use their knowledge of adding up to 10 to add up to 20. Understand that the addition is commutative (the total is the same when adding – i.e. 7+3 is the same as 3+7) but that they |
| | should start with the larger number in order to add on more efficiently. Explain that they are |
| | adding on to what they already have and are not adding two separate items. Use the attached |
| | worksheet to practise counting on. |

| | Topic: Research with an adult different animal skins (i.e. zebra, cheetah, snake) What |
| | shapes, colours and patterns can you see? Using crayon, chalk or pencils have a go at |
| | recreating one of these on an A4 piece of paper. |

| | Maths: Find and make number bonds - https://vimeo.com/490882337 |
| | Chn to use their knowledge of number bonds to 10 to find numbers bonds to 20. When using |
| | a number bond to 10 to make a number bond to 20, explain that the ones will stay the same |
| | but one number will also have one ten. Eg 7 + 3 could become 17 + 3 or 7 +13 when a ten is |
| | added to one of the numbers. Practise recording the number bonds to 10 and then 20. |
| | English: Tomorrow we will be writing our own version of Dear Zoo. Today plan out your own |
| | version by drawing pictures of the animals you would like to include in your story. For |
| | example; "a crocodile snappy" - "a kangaroo bouncy" Use a word to describe them. |

| | full stops and to sit your letters on the line. |
