DAY	DAILY ACTIVITIES
Monday	<p>Phonics: Refer to the attached template on our alternative spellings this week “igh/ie/i-e/y”</p> <p>English: Listen to the story “The Selfish Crocodile” using the following link: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=0-NhjfJ_RZI. Talk about how the crocodile realised he should have been a better friend. Sort the attached picture cards into ‘friendly’ and ‘unfriendly’ behaviours.</p> <p>Maths: Subtraction – not crossing 10. Use the video (https://vimeo.com/492197096) to recap subtraction and how this can be shown in various ways and using different methods. Complete the attached worksheet.</p> <p>Topic: We are learning about reptiles this week. Use the following link (https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=-rDjqhFJrFI) to find out what you can about this animal group. Make a poster with drawings and captions naming some reptiles and their features.</p>
Tuesday	<p>Phonics: Refer to the attached template on our alternative spellings this week “igh/ie/i-e/y”</p> <p>English: Recap the story of ‘The Selfish Crocodile’ from yesterday. Discuss ways we can keep our teeth healthy. Use the attached template to record three of these ideas.</p> <p>Maths: Practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s using the following link (https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=7AnoVea8UCM). Wednesday	<p>Phonics: Refer to the attached template on our alternative spellings this week “igh/ie/i-e/y”</p> <p>English: With an adult to read the questions, have a go at our next Grammar Hammer skills check. Remember much of this has yet to be taught in class, but practise as much as you can independently.</p> <p>Maths: Subtraction - counting back. Use the video (https://vimeo.com/492198226) and complete the attached worksheet to continue our learning for this week.</p> <p>Science: Use the Grouping Animals PowerPoint to learn more about different animal groups. Complete the sorting activity afterwards by cutting the pictures out and sticking them under the right heading.</p>
