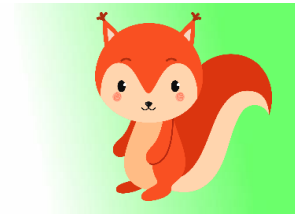

Week 6 8.2.21

Topic: Paws, Claws & Whiskers

Every day look at the day and date. What day is it? How many days in the week? What day will it be tomorrow? What day was it yesterday? What is the date (for example 11th)? How many one's in 11, how many tens. How many more do I need to make 10/20? What month is it? How many months in the year? If January is the first month, which month is the third month?

We do these routines each day so the children will be used to answering the questions.

Sing the numbers song. Sing the counting in 2's/5's song. Count in 10's. Count backwards. Say three numbers in sequence, your child says the next three numbers (up to 100 or further if you can). Helpful websites for songs are below.
