

### Pick-up and drop-off arrangements

Thank you for providing such positive feedback on our new pick-up and drop-off arrangements this week. I know how busy family life is and recognise that many of our families are juggling different home and work commitments. Please read on below for some clarifications on drop-off arrangements:

In line with our safeguarding protocols, it is vital that no parents or carers enter the inside of the school building unless they are accompanied by a member of staff at all times.

If you arrive for drop-off between 8:30am and 8:40am, please accompany your child to outside their classroom. They will be able to enter their classroom when the doors open at 8:40am.

If you arrive for drop-off between 8:40am and 8:50am, you have the choice of accompanying your child to their classroom or dropping them off at the gate, as their classroom doors will already have opened.

If you arrive for drop-off after 8:50am, please take your child straight to the office to be signed in (even if the gate is still open), as their class teacher will already have started registration.

To keep everyone safe, please ensure that children do not use any playground equipment or resources in their year group's outdoor area if they wait with a parent or carer on the playground.

This week, the spotlight is on our year 1 and 2 classes.

In year 1, we have been learning about the seasons of the year and the weather in science. Each week we have covered a different season. This week, our focus was on autumn. Together as a year group, we went on an autumn walk around our outside area and collected lots of interesting things. We spent time using magnifying glasses to explore our findings further; we also did some leaf rubbings and created our own autumn collages.







In year 2, we have been learning about the Victorians in history this half term. We made our own telephones and used our outdoor area to plot a timeline of key events.











### YES Day! Friday 20th October 2023


For one day only, Mr Lodge is going to say YES to some of the usual school rules being relaxed, in exchange for a donation to the PTA. We have agreed that:
