Please can we remind parents and carers that if you take your child out of school without authority, you will be liable to receive a penalty notice. Currently, the amount payable under the penalty notice is £60 per parent/carer per child if paid within 21 days. Thereafter, the amount increases to £120 if paid within 21 to 28 days. If this remains unpaid after 28 days, the local authority may consider a prosecution in the Magistrate's Court. Since penalty notices are issued per parent/carer per child, a family of two parents and two children will receive four penalty notices. Please note that this is not a source of income for the school and is dealt with directly from Surrey County Council.
