

As part of our collaboration in ensuring that all of our children are as happy and as healthy as possible, we hugely appreciate your support with making sure that your child attends school as regularly as they can. We know that sometimes our children cannot come to school because they are really unwell, and that is the right thing to do for them and others. If you and your child arrive after 8:50am, we ask that you go straight to the office to sign in and enter the building via the office. Upon arrival at the office, please give a reason for the lateness, which will be added to the register. Your child will then walk, or be escorted, to their classroom.

Spotlight on KS1...

This week, the spotlight is on our year 1 and 2 classes.
