Dear parents and carers,

Across the school, it has been fantastic to see the children thoroughly enjoying their new learning. We are excited to share with you our very first 'Spotlight on' section, which this week focus on the work of the children within our Early Years Foundation Stage classes. Our year 1 and 2 children have also settled into school exceptionally well and we are very proud of them!




General updates Harvest Collection
