Spotlight on EYFS..



This week, the spotlight is on our **Nursery and Reception classes.**

In Nursery, we have explored the theme of Family and Celebrations through the stories 'Funnybones' and 'We're Going on a Pumpkin Hunt'. The children have enjoyed investigating a variety of pumpkins, developing their fine motor skills through cutting, scooping and sawing. This has helped with supporting their strength and independence when learning to do coat zips. We have also had great fun learning how to play our first team game 'Domes and Dishes' in PE.







In Reception, we have begun our new topic of 'Celebrations' and have enjoyed learning about fireworks night. We have been learning how to keep ourselves safe around fireworks and have enjoyed using our phonics to label our firework drawings. In maths we have been learning about shapes and enjoyed creating our own representation of Kandinsky's concentric circles. We have also enjoyed reading 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears' and have had lots of fun using masks and props to act out the story.

Transition Support Videos

A pre-recorded workshop for parents and carers,
