The boy parachutes to earth to get some tools to fix the rocket

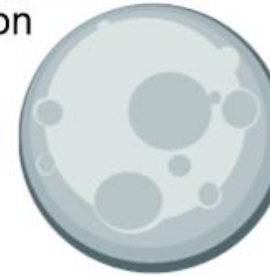
