The King's wife is Queen Letizia and they have two daughters, Leonor and Sofia.

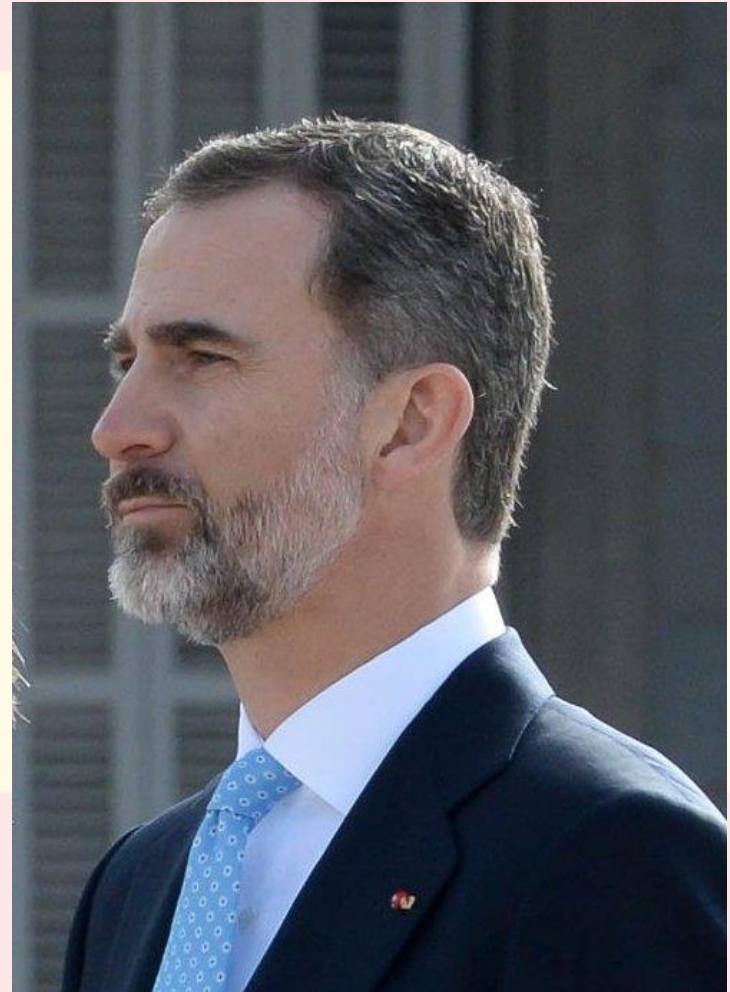
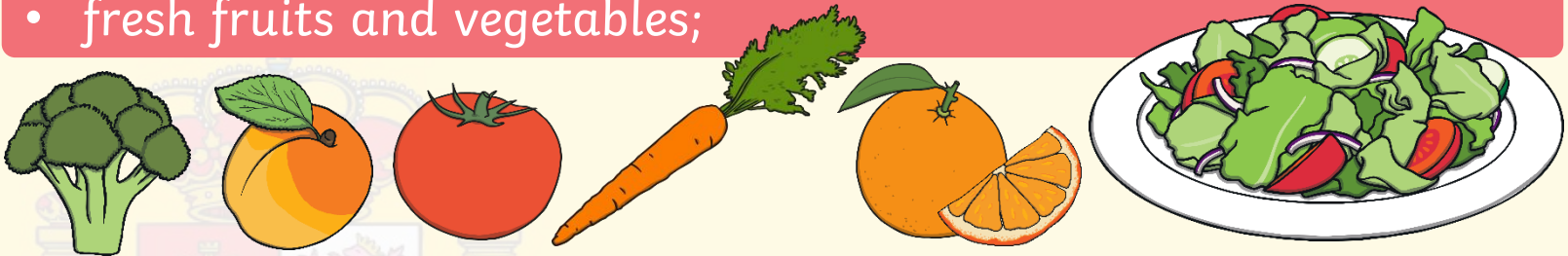

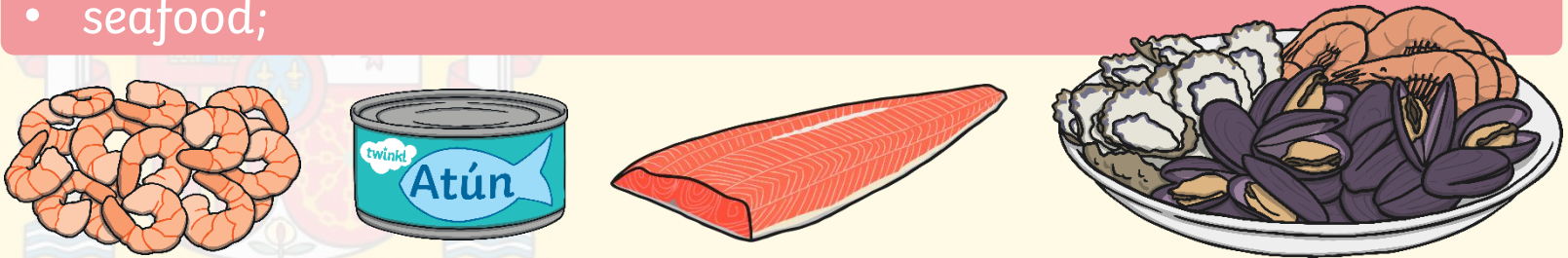
Spanish Food

The Spanish have a Mediterranean diet. They eat lots of:

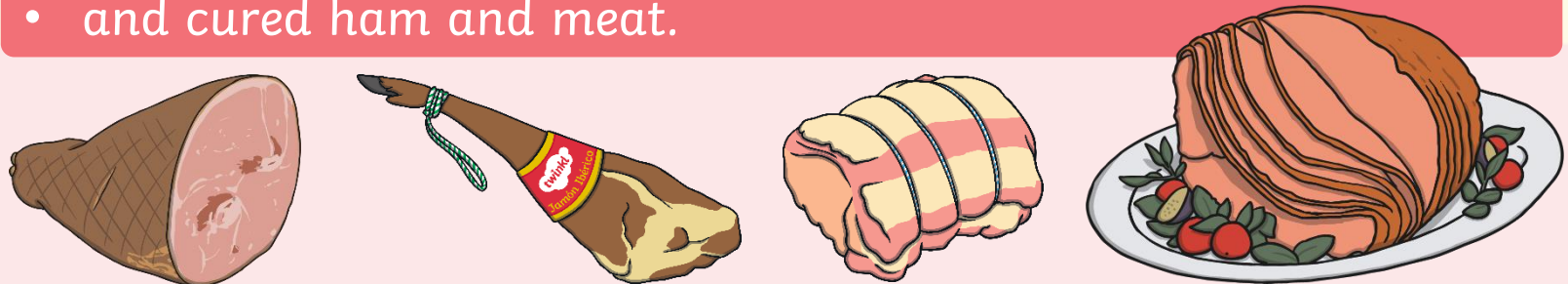
- fresh fruits and vegetables;



- seafood;



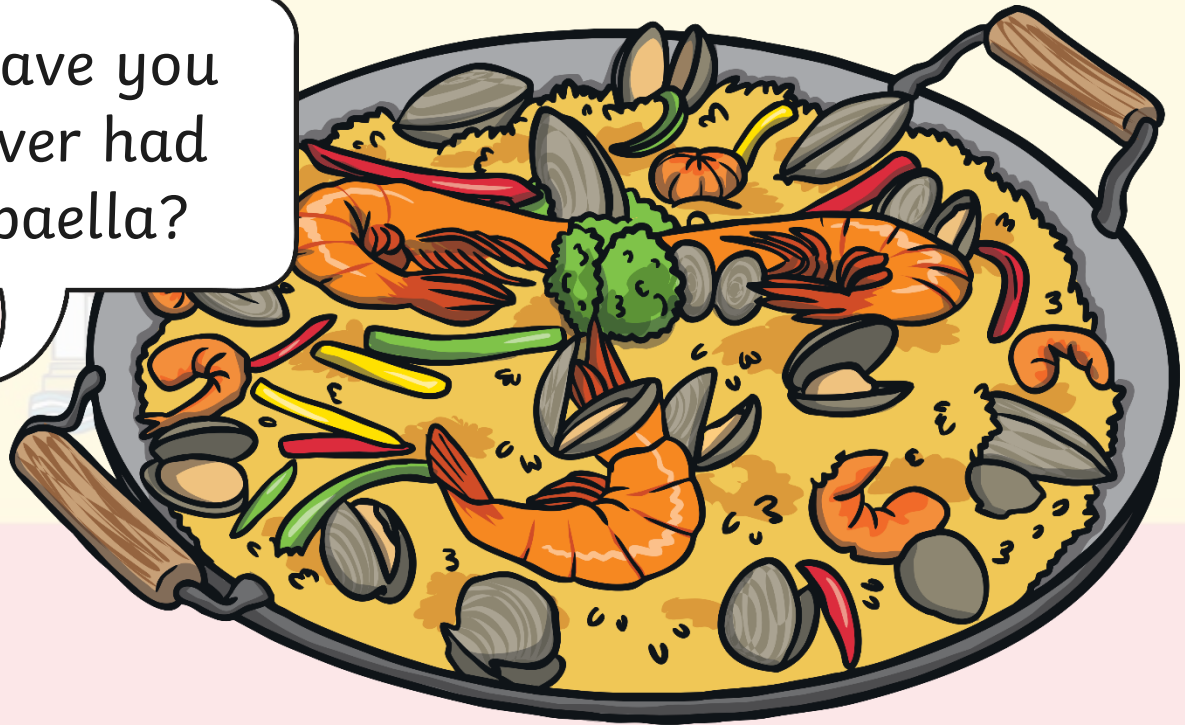
- and cured ham and meat.

A very popular dish in Spain is paella. This is traditionally cooked in a large pan. Common ingredients in paella are rice, saffron, seafood and chicken.

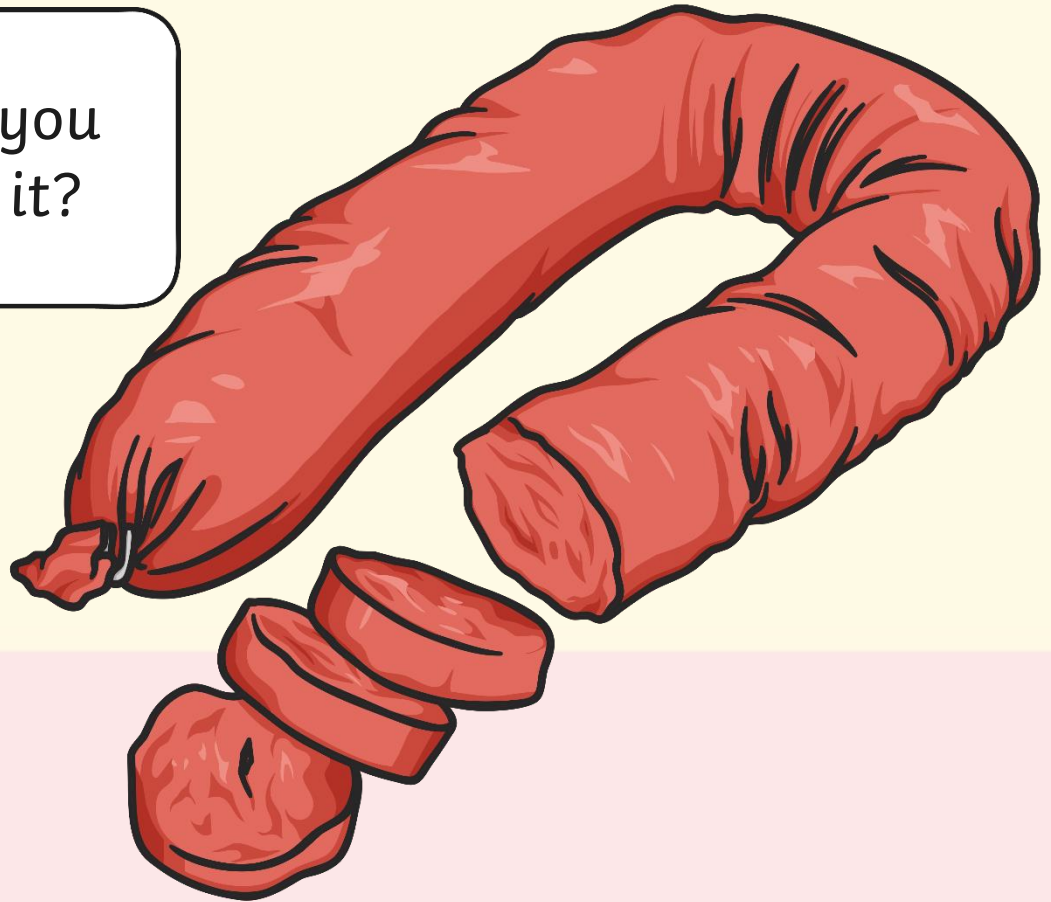
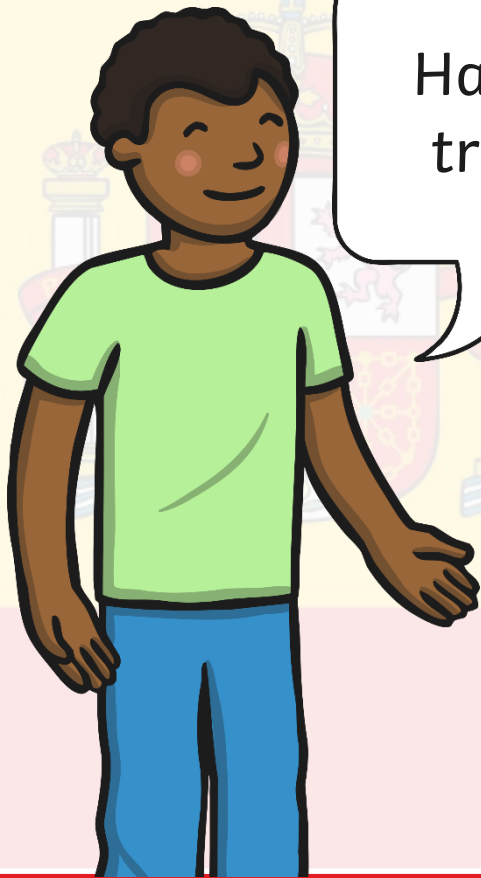
